Dear friends

Thank you to those who came along last Wednesday evening for the presentation by Fr Joe Caddy and Cath Garner. It was good to meet the parishioners of East Hampton also as they are now part of our Bayside Family. It was good for us to gather as a Bayside community together.

As we stated last week, the weekend Mass times at East Hampton will remain for a few weeks to allow some time for discussion and discernment with the wider community. It will mean a change for others in the Mission also, so we ask for your understanding and patience. The important thing is that we all have access to Mass and the sacraments, although it may be at a different place and time. This is something that we will have to get used to in the future. Our Working Group will further discuss this on Tuesday night.

You will see on the website the 'Issues and Responses' paper from the amalgamation consultation and in the churches a timeline of the process so far. The Working Group have discerned that we agree to take the next step of advising the Archbishop of our intentions and providing him with the documentation that we have prepared for the communities. In concert with this, the Working Group will continue the process of listening and discernment with our communities as this formal process is likely to take several months for any formal decision.

From this Monday, October 24, the Monday morning Mass will be at Immaculate Heart, not St Mary's. This will be the only weekday Mass at Immaculate Heart at the moment. I will be celebrating the three Mass at Immaculate Heart this weekend.

THE EUCHARIST

The Church draws her life from the Eucharist. This truth does not simply express a daily experience of faith, but recapitulates the heart of the mystery of the Church. In a variety of ways she joyfully experiences the constant fulfilment of the promise: "Lo, I am with you always, to the close of the age" (Mt 28:20), but in the Holy Eucharist, through the changing of bread and wine into the body and blood of the Lord, she rejoices in this presence with unique intensity. Ever since Pentecost, when the Church, the People of the New Covenant, began her pilgrim journey towards her heavenly homeland, the Divine Sacrament has continued to mark the passing of her days, filling them with confident hope.

The Second Vatican Council rightly proclaimed that the Eucharistic sacrifice is "the source and summit of the Christian life". "For the most holy Eucharist contains the Church's entire spiritual wealth: Christ himself, our passover and living bread. Through his own flesh, now made living and life-giving by the Holy Spirit, he offers life to men". Consequently the gaze of the Church is constantly turned to her Lord, present in the Sacrament of the Altar, in which she discovers the full manifestation of his boundless love.

Music in the Mass - Music Speaks to the Soul

Music touches the human soul in a deep way. Sometimes we need to let the music in the liturgy touch us and 'speak' to us using a receptive mode. That is. God can speak to us through this if we put aside our personal choices and opinions and be open to new things and the promptings of the Holy Spirit through music and song and the gifts of others who serve the assembly in this ministry.

'Pastors of souls, having taken into consideration pastoral usefulness and the character of their own language, should see whether parts of the heritage of sacred music, written in previous centuries for Latin texts, could also be conveniently used, not only in liturgical celebrations in Latin but also in those performed in the vernacular. There is nothing to prevent different parts in one and the same celebration being sung in different languages.'
